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Here are some of the most common examples of suspicious online activity:

DATABASE ACTIVITY:

Watch out for changes in your users, permissions, and unusual data content growth. This can be caused by either internal or external attacks.

CYBER ATTACK:

Disrupting or compromising an organization's information technology systems.

ACCOUNT ABUSE:

Watch out for audit trails, sharing account access, and accessing sensitive information.

FILE CHANGES:

Watch out for changes to files including replacement, modifications, file additions, and deletion.

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
